

Attendance

As you can see from the weekly totals at the beginning of the newsletter, we are frequently having class attendance levels well below the expected level of 96%. We do understand that for some children this is related to illness but there are others who could be in school who aren't. It is so important for children to attend regularly and on time in order to ensure that they get the most out of all the learning opportunities they they are given.

This term we have introduced our Attendance Team who have been visiting houses to both check on children who we haven't seen and also to support families in getting children back into school. Thank you for the overwhelmingly positive response to this supportive work, we have already seen clear improvements in levels of attendance for many children.
