- Discuss colours of clothing

- Colour matching dominoes/jigsaws
- Read colour matching books
- Coloured playdough activities
- ullet lce biscuits or cakes using different colours

Practical ideas to help your child

Children will learn about simple number order through repetition and practical guidance. As well as this, children will reinforce their knowledge of adding and subtracting through these number songs.


