Practical ideas to help your child

- Go on a shape hunt take photos on iPad to look at back home
- Print shapes with potatoes and paint
- Shape matching dominoes/ jigsaws
- Identify and name shapes in books

- Make shape pictures/cut shapes out/draw round shapes
- Use different shaped cutters in playdough/biscuit mix
- Make shapes using earbuds
