How do we know about the London Great Plague victims?

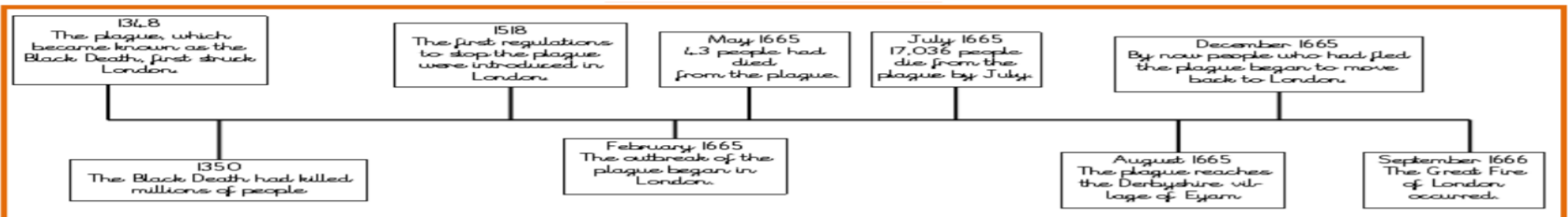
