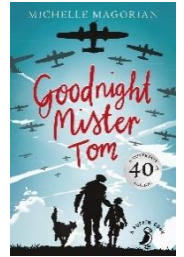
Year 6 Curriculum Letter

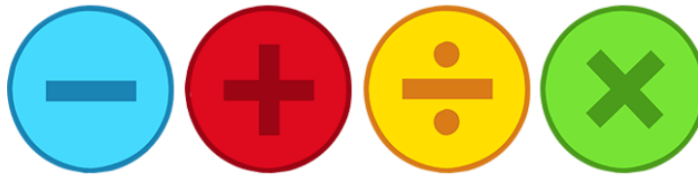
English

The first half term we will be looking at a famous piece of classic fiction. We will be exploring "Goodnight Mister Tom" which is set in the countryside at the start of World War 2. We will develop our retrieval and inference skills as well as consolidating key skills we must be secure in e.g capital letters, commas and inverted commas. After this unit we will spend some time looking at biographies of famous historical figures from World War 2.



Maths

For the first half term we will begin by looking at our place value skills up to 10,000,000 including ordering, sorting and identifying values of different places. We will then be looking at the four operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division and finding the most efficient methods for each.



Creative Curriculum

This term our topic is "A World at War". Our focus is on World War 2 and the impact this had on Britain. Our Geography will look at key countries, continents and oceans as well as key features of the world. Our History will look at how WW2 began and what this meant for people in Europe. We will be designing and making food based on rations such as bread and different soups which made the most of what was available. We will learn and appraise songs from WW2 and use our knowledge of light to create periscopes and use Morse code.
