Welcome back! We hope you have all had a lovely break. Below is an outline of some of the exciting things your children will be learning this half term.

English

In English this half term we will start by looking at stories from familiar settings. We will be looking at stories set on a farmyard and create our own stories with a problem based around the farm. We will also create persuasive leaflets and posters to encourage people to come to our farms that we will create. Then we will create riddles on something that you will find on the farm.



Maths



In Maths we will begin by consolidating our work last term on money. We will then be moving on to multiplication and division followed by looking at graphs and statistics. Please keep practicing 2x, 5x and 10x tables at home as well as the 3x table which we will begin learning this half term.

Curriculum

Our topic this half term is 'The Farm Shop'. In this topic we are going to be finding out how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants, as well as how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy. We will also be looking at where our food comes from. We will be creating our own salad and using our English skills to persuade people to want to buy our salads that we will create.



RE

During this term our topic in RE will be 'Jesus, friend to everyone'. We will read stories of Jesus' miracles and discuss how Christians believe Jesus was an extraordinary person who welcomed everyone as a friend.

PE

This half term we are going to be doing consolidating our skills in running, jumping and throwing as well as attack, defend and shoot.

Computing



In computing we will develop classification skills by carrying out sorting activities as well as making pictograms and bar charts. We will then interpret the graphs and discuss the information, answering simple questions.

PSHE

This half term our PSHE sessions will begin the year with one of our growth mindset lessons. Our whole school topic is 'Aspire to be...'. We will be looking at our living in the wider world topic money and work. We will be focussing on what money is and how we can look after money and use it for out needs and wants.

Music

In music we will be learning a reggae song called 'Zootime'. We will start by singing the song, learning how to play it using the glockenspiels then using the song to help us improvise and compose our own music.
