Happy New Year! Below is an outline of some of the exciting things your children will be learning this half term. Please remember reading books are to be in school every day and PE kits can be worn all day when the children have PE.

English

During our English lessons, we will be focusing on the work of William Shakespeare and specifically, Romeo and Juliet. This unit will give children the opportunity to appreciate the work of the legendary play writer whilst unpicking the meaning of much of his work. There will be a number of opportunities for children to explore his work via drama alongside film clips to enhance understanding and even write in his style of iambic Pentameter. We will also continue to learn a range of grammar, punctuation and spellings skills.



Maths

This is what we will be learning of the course of this half term in our groups. Addition and subtraction of decimals will be happening with Mrs Simpson's group while Mr Ward's will be finalizing their work on fractions before progressing to decimals and percentages and the relationship between the three.

Creative Curriculum

Our theme this half term is Heroes and Villains. During this unit, children will be given the opportunity to learn about the digestive system and the role it plays within our bodies. In our DT, we will be considering food packaging before moving on to how to create a healthy bread which is both tasty and nourishing for us.

R.E

Our unit this term will be focusing on why Christians celebrate the Eucharist. We will explore what it is and discuss the significance of this for Christians and make links to children's lives. During the unit we will read a range of extracts from the Bible to enhance learning.



PE

This term in PE we will be working with Mrs Howard working on our fitness and learning a range of new dance moves. We will also be improving our football skills outside on the MUGGA. Please check Dojo each week to see when we will be doing P.E as the days may change.

Computing

Over the course of this half term children will be developing their use of spreadsheets and exploring how this can be used in everyday life to make things easier. Spreadsheets will be created to show probability, budget spending money and plan for upcoming events.

PSHE

This term we will be learning about the role that money plays in people's lives, attitudes towards it and what influences our decisions about it. We will learn about value for money, how companies encourage customers to buy things and why it is important to be a critical consumer.
