**Please read to your child as much as you can, keep listening out for different sounds.**

<b>Phonics</b>	Use pots, pans and any other items that you can bang to make sounds. The louder the better!!	Go outside and use a stick to bang on different surfaces such as the bin, door, wall, floor, fences etc. Can your child hear the different sounds	Google cvc pictures and you will find pictures with three letter words come up. Sound talk with your child some of these	Use various size plastic bottles and put things in them such as pasta, rice, water etc listen to the different sounds they make. Then hide and shake and see if your child recognises which one it is	Play 'I spy with my little eye'. Have the objects in front of your child to make it easier for them.
<b>Literacy</b>	Watch the video re-telling the story of the Gruffalo <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=s8sUPpPc8Ws">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=s8sUPpPc8Ws</a>	Order the story of the Gruffalo using the pictures	Draw the story of the gruffalo, can you remember the sequence of the story. Look at the story board to help.	Talk about the characters in the story, look at either the youtube video of the story or the sequencing that you have done	Draw another animal character on the sheet provided and tell the story.
<b>Maths</b>	For this activity you will need lots of 1, 2, 5 and 10 pence pieces. Your child will need to sort them out and then talk about the number on them.	This is the same as the literacy above but when ordering the story put them into the correct number boxes 1, 2, 3, etc	Create your own dice either use a box cover it with white paper and add dots or make it with the net provided.	Number formation sheet that can be done and as your child is completing it go through the numbers	Have various objects out such as 1 spoon, 2 pens, 3 cups etc to 10 depending on your child's ability. Ask them to count and write the correct number of each object.
<b>Other subjects:</b> Creative	Make Gruffalo crumble using rice crispies and melted chocolate. You can be imaginative and use marshmallows, cookies and anything else you would like	Parents hide the characters around the house children have to find them and match it to the board	Make the mouse, snake and fox masks	Make the Gruffalo and owl masks. Put the masks on sticks and re-tell the story. Thinking about who the characters are.	Outline of Gruffalo decorate it using different media such as sticks, various papers, material, cotton wool etc. For ideas look at the one that was made.

<b>Extra activities:</b>	Go for a walk and talk about what they see. When passing shops and ask questions such as what do you think they sell and how do they know?
