<b>Phonics</b>	Watch my sound – look in the mirror and make different sounds, open your mouth wide, shake your tongue around, make a quiet sound, make a long sound eeeeeee etc. see what happens to the shape of your mouth. Go on a sound walk and listen out for sounds that you will find in your home and outdoors. Eg washing machine tap. Toilet flushing. Outside seagulls, pigeons, traffic, sirens.

Think of what power your superhero is going to have. For example does it run fast, can it jump over buildings, can it fly. Write the power it has and its name on your design.		Alliteration which means words that begin with the same letter. Eg naughty Neil or strong Sammy. <b>Maths</b>	Make a pattern using 2 coloured objects such as lego, bricks, beads etc eg red, blue, red, blue. Then record it on the pattern sheet. Can you make more patterns.	Use frozen peas and pegs to pick up a given number. Parent says a number the child puts that many into a bowl.
