PHONICS

Children will be reading words and story books using the Set 1,2 and 3 sounds that they know. They will write words and sentences using the sounds they know.

ENGLISH

Using 'The Last Wolf' by Mini Grey we will be practising the writing skills we need to use, to help us write a persuasive letter.

Year 2

MATHS

The children will be learning about fraction, where they will be finding half, quarters and thirds of numbers and shapes.

After fractions we will be learning about time, where the children will learn how to read both a digital clock and an analogue clock to the nearest 5 minutes.

SCIENCE

Growing up The children will be learning about the life cycles of different animals, including humans, amphibians and butterflies.
