Programming

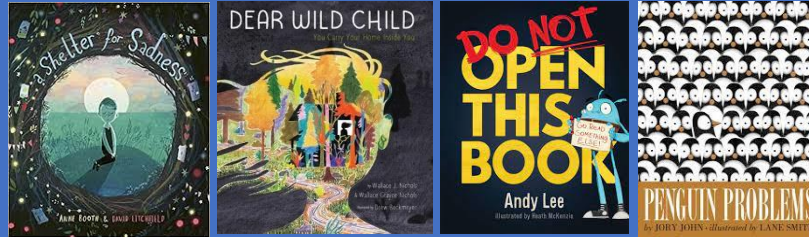
Using Looking Glass, children create animations and games through creative exploration and develop the fundamental principles of programming.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Striking and Fielding

The children will be taking part in Cricket and Rounders with a focus on batting and bowling.

MUSIC

Songs of World War 2

The children will be learning and performing songs from WW2.

MATHS

In the shape topic, we will be learning how to use a protractor to measure an angle and recapping the different classification of angles.

In the Position and Direction topic, Children will be drawing shapes on a coordinate grid. They will solve problems in the first quadrant without the support of grid lines.

We will also be using all of our maths skills for our end of year Enterprise project!

SCIENCE

Variation

The children will be learning to compare different species and organisms, whilst explaining how characteristics are inherited.

Adaptations
