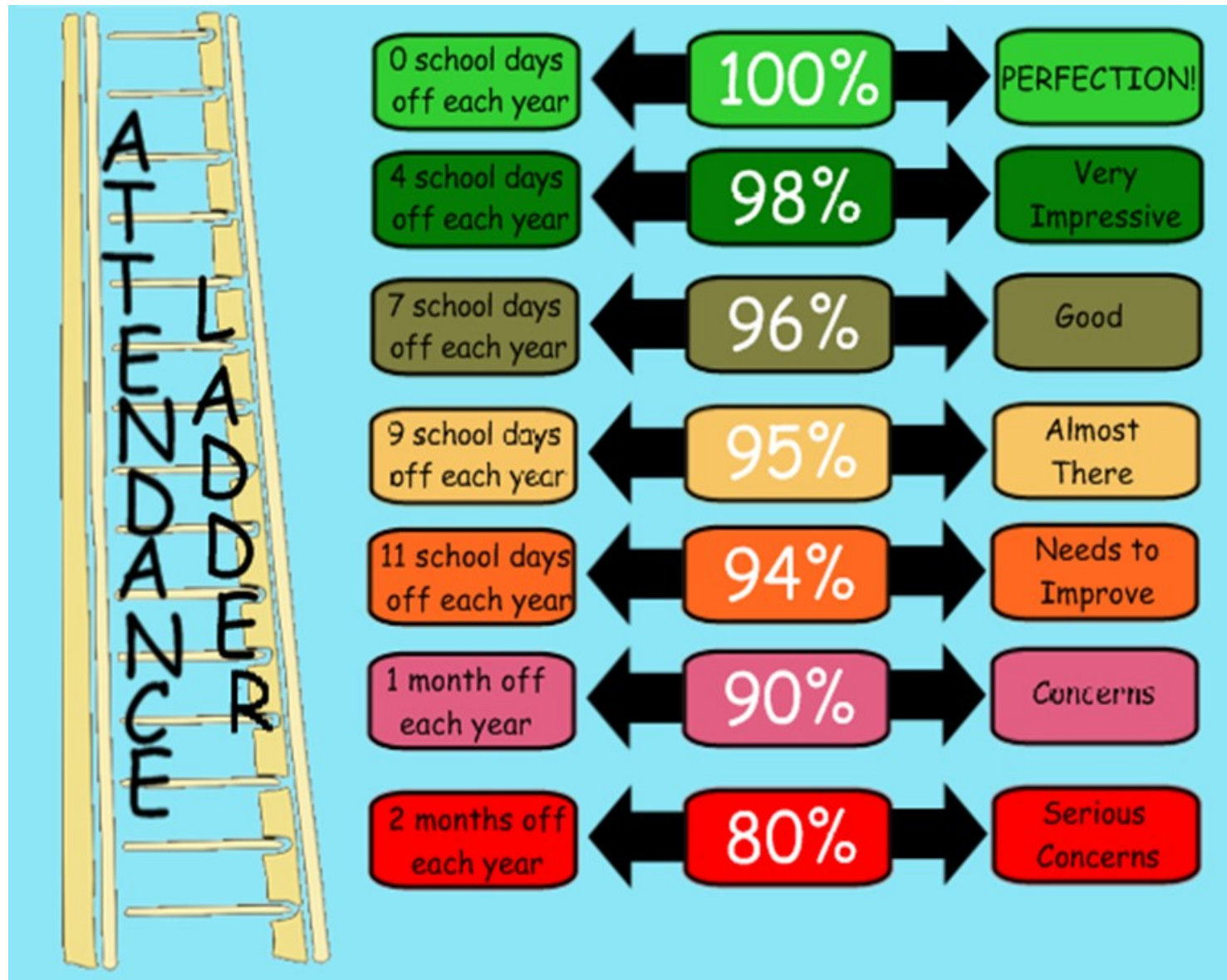
## A note from the Headteacher

## The School Day

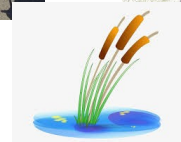
# Sport

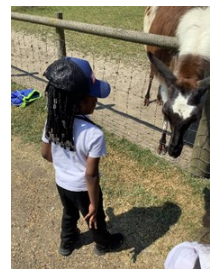
# Nursery
