Curriculum Overview

Spring Term 1



MATHS

In the Spring term 1 we will be focusing on numbers to 20, place value and addition to 20.

This children will still continue to develop their understand of numbers within 20 as well as learning to count in 2s, 5s, and 10s.

SCIENCE

Plants and Animals

This term we will be looking at the changes of a seed over time and the different parts of the plant. We will also start to explore categories of animals including mammals, fish, reptiles, birds and amphibians.

ART

Colour mixing

This term the children will be exploring colouring mixing as well as learning about primary and secondary colours.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

The children will be learning about dance skills. Each class has two weekly lessons.

1D – Monday and Tuesday
1M – Wednesday and Friday

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

Jesus was special

This term the children will be learning how Jesus was special and exploring the Bible stories that show Jesus' power and divine nature.

HISTORY

How toys have changed.

The children will be sequencing toys on a time-line, investigating artefacts from the past, identifying how teddy bears have changed and what toys may be like in the future.

Geography

This term we will be focusing on history and on our Geography topic next term.

COMPUTING

Computer Science

In this unit children will be exploring simple algorithms, how to create programs and use logical reasoning to predict the behaviour of simple programs.

PSHE

Health and Wellbeing

This term the children will continue to focus on their emotions as well as looking at how to keep our bodies and our mind healthy.

MUSIC

Dynamics

Children make links between music, sounds and environments and use percussion, vocal and body sounds to represent calm or stormy seas.
