



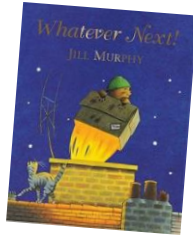

To help improve the children's language and communication skills we will focus on:

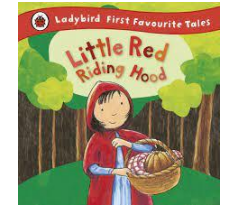
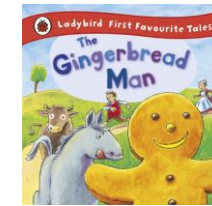
- Winter
