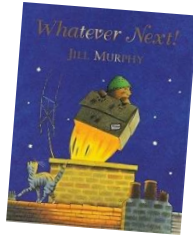

Reading to children is the best way of encouraging them to love books and reading. In

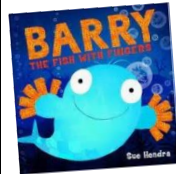


Nursery we read stories every day and the children will have lots of opportunities to read for themselves.

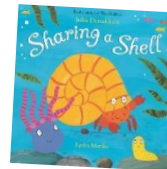
Each week the children will come home with a Library Book which they will have chosen from our Lending Library. Please read and talk about this book at home with your child.
