# Big focus on reading this year!

#### What we can do:

Children will be working in groups and following the RWI scheme.

In Autumn term we will be focusing on:

# **Spellings**

Children will learn new spellings every week.

They will get a new list weekly.

They need to practise these at home (e.g. look, cover, write)

Spelling test every Friday.

Following the PowerMaths scheme of work – practical and interactive lessons, building up concepts in small progressive steps, checks understanding of all children.

Children will need to know their 2x, 3x, 5x and 10x table by the end of the year. Timestable Rockstars can be accessed from home to work on these skills.

We will be doing weekly basic skills and arithmetic tests.

Children will be tested on timestables weekly. This half term we are focusing on 2x table.
