

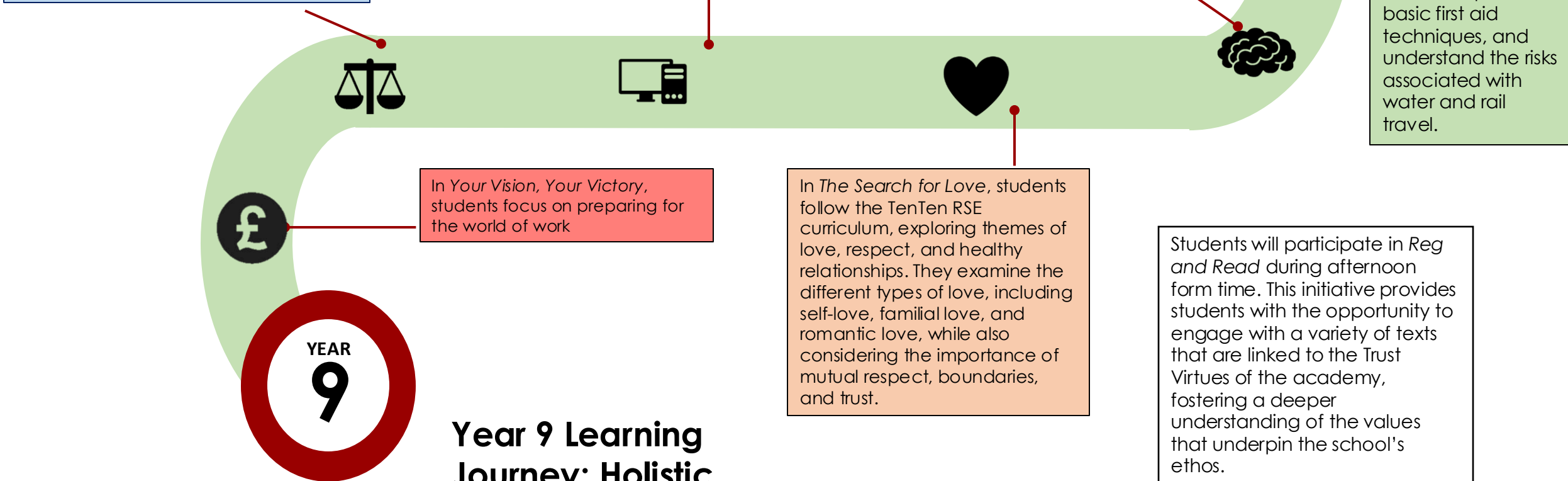
In *From Tea to Democracy*, students explore the importance of voting and making informed political decisions. They learn about freedom of speech, diversity, and the impact of immigration on British society. This unit encourages thoughtful engagement with current issues and helps students understand their role in building a fair, inclusive, and democratic society.

In *Master the Digital Wave*, students explore modern digital challenges including AI, cancel culture, influencers, and the dangers of online extremism. They develop critical thinking skills to navigate digital trends safely and responsibly, reflecting on how online content shapes opinions, behaviour, and society.

In *Mental Health Unplugged*, students consider how everyday factors—such as school pressures, social media, and comparison culture—can impact their mental health. They explore how these influences affect self-esteem, stress levels, and emotional well-being.

In *Stay Calm, Stay Safe*, students explore essential safety skills, including first aid, water safety, and railway safety. They learn how to respond in emergency situations, practice basic first aid techniques, and understand the risks associated with water and rail travel.
