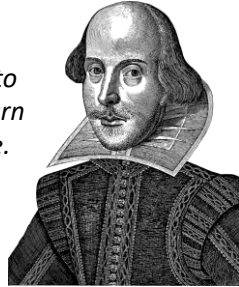


Year 7 Learning Journey: English

Half Term 4

This half term you will be introduced to poetry analysis. You will read a range of poems linked to the theme of 'love and relationships' and will learn about methods that are unique to this text type.

Finally, you will conclude the year with an introduction to William Shakespeare. You will learn about his life, the time in which he lived and will read scenes from some of his most well-known plays,

Writing Assessment: Non-fiction writing.

By the end of Year 7:

- ✓ You will have developed knowledge of literature from different eras: Elizabethan, Jacobean, Victorian, 20th and 21st centuries.
- ✓ You will know the key features of poetry, plays and novels.
- ✓ You will be able to use quotations to support your reading responses.
- ✓ You will have developed your writing skills and will be able to match your writing to purpose and audience using some appropriate devices.

How will you be assessed in English?

- You will be formally assessed six times throughout the year. Three times on writing skills and three times on reading skills.
- You will also complete two oracy assessments this year. These will assess your speaking and listening skills.
- You will have three pieces of homework per unit: a reading task, a skills task and a recall mat.
- Each lesson will begin with a 'student engage' task which will connect to your prior learning and allow you to assess your own knowledge.
