Standards Reminder

I hope this letter finds you well. As we begin the final term of the academic year, I would like to take this opportunity to remind parents and carers of the high standards we expect at St Michael's. Your continued support with the expectations outlined below is greatly appreciated, as they play an important role in ensuring positive outcomes for all our students.

Uniform Expectations

We always expect excellent standards of uniform. Uniform compliance is checked daily by the pastoral team and students are expected to meet the following requirements:

- Blazers must be worn at all times when students are moving around the school building, including during lesson changeovers and when attending assemblies.
- Trainers or boots are not permitted, unless supported by genuine medical documentation.
- Jewellery is not permitted, with the exception of one plain stud earring per ear. Any additional jewellery will be confiscated, and parents will be asked to collect item(s) from school.
- False nails are not permitted. Nails should be of a natural length and appearance to ensure safety in lessons, particularly in practical subjects.
- Extreme or unnatural hair colours are not permitted.
