The test will last approximately 40 minutes.

What do I need to revise for this assessment?

Must know Key words:

Where can I find help with revision?

1. Revise all your vocabulary lists (see vocabulary book).
2. Go through homework 2 carefully.
3. In your exercise book, go through the piece of extended writing that you have produced.
4. Use your knowledge organiser as it summarises the essential content of every lesson of this module.
5. Use the enquiry questions at the back of your knowledge organiser to consolidate the learning (questions and answers) done in class.
