What do I need to revise for this assessment?

Throughout this module, you have practised in class and at home vocabulary, grammar and phonics through the skills of Listening, Reading, Speaking and Writing.

It is important that you are confident with the vocabulary and structures covered in this module.

Must know Key words:

All the must know key words are recorded in your vocab book and in your knowledge organizer.

Question types and guidance:

Grammar exercises: be confident about the verbs we have covered in the present, future and perfect tense when talking about where you live. Remember the difference between the present and the past e.g. je/ j'ai, e/ é, c'est/ c'était and the future "je vais"+ infinitive, ce sera. Revise the time-phrases to work out which tense you need.

Writing task: write in full sentences on the given bullet points. Remember to express some opinions with justifications.

Speaking: the speaking assessment has 2 parts. First you will be asked to read aloud a few sentences. Then you will be asked 3 to 5 questions from the enquiry questions of your knowledge organiser.

Where can I find help with revision?

1. Revise all your vocabulary lists (see vocabulary book).
2. Go through homework 3 and 4 carefully.
3. In your exercise book, go through the piece of extended writing that you have produced.
4. Your planning sheet for your extended piece of writing is a very good summary of the work covered in this module.
5. Use your knowledge organiser as it summarises the essential content of every lesson of this module.
6. Use your knowledge organiser to revise for your speaking assessment. Learn the first three enquiry questions and answers.
