Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 11 Easter Revision

As we approach the Easter break, I would like to outline the support in place to help your child prepare for their GCSE examinations. Your child should be doing a few hours of independent revision each day through the holidays. Revision completed over the holiday will make a significant difference to students' confidence and outcomes this summer.

All Year 11 students will receive a revision planner, a personalised list of exam entries and subject-specific holiday homework. They can also access the Pearson Revise materials via the "Parents" section of our website under "Useful links".

School-led Easter revision sessions will run throughout the holiday, delivered by subject specialists. These small-group sessions offer focused support and a chance to revisit key knowledge. The timetable is enclosed. Please ensure your child attends as many sessions as possible and sign them up using the link provided or the QR code on the timetable.

Students attending holiday revision sessions at school do not need to wear uniform but should bring writing equipment and relevant materials. For safeguarding, all students must sign in and out at the main reception. Please note the school canteen will be closed. Students should bring food and drinks or make off-site arrangements at lunchtime.

Following Easter, after-school Exam Preparation sessions will run Monday to Thursday (3:30–4:15pm) for three weeks. A minibus to Port Clarence, Norton and Wynyard can be booked via student reception for those who normally use school transport.

Once exams begin, the Year 11 timetable will be collapsed to provide targeted revision before each paper, alongside additional after-school sessions. Students will receive full details when they return after Easter.

Thank you for your continued support as we work together to secure the best possible outcomes for your child.
