Dear parents and Carers,

We are about to start the Year 11 mock exams which will give us an excellent indication of how well your child is currently doing, and a good indication of how well they may do in the summer exam series.

I think it is fair to say that all Year 11 students have found this first term demanding and challenging as they start to really understand the amount of work that it is necessary to complete, to be able to achieve their target grades across their GCSE subjects. I want to say how proud I am of all those students who have been totally dedicated to their studies, including homework and exam preparation since the start of September – I am sure we will start to see this bear fruit in the mock exams.

Students have been taken through the full arrangements and expectations for the exam series, and I hope they are feeling well prepared. For the first time, we will be able to offer students the opportunity to have friendship group and other group photographs, something that I know many students are very keen to be able to do.

The last day will also be a half day with the buses coming to collect students from school at 12.45pm. This should mean that Year 11 students are able to have a lovely end to this very busy term. Students know that when they return in January, time will pass quickly, and we will be expecting them to be focused and working hard right up to the May exams.
