Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 11 Examination Information Packs

We are now less than a week away from our first GCSE examinations! Students studying Travel and Tourism will begin this Friday, with everyone else starting their examinations a week on Thursday, with RE on Thursday 9 May. Year 11 students have been given some important examination packs to help them through the forthcoming exam season. The examination packs contain:

- 1) A personal examination timetable: This formal timetable contains only the exams your son/daughter has been entered for. Please keep this safe and note the dates and times of each examination.
- 2) Here is a copy of the year 11 collapsed timetable: Students' timetables have been carefully planned and restructured around the examinations to ensure that students have high-quality revision sessions in the lead-up to each exam.
- 3) Examination Information Booklet: This booklet contains revision lists and essential information for each examination. It is set out daily rather than subject by subject so that students know what will be on each paper in order and will always know what is coming up next.
- 4) **A Revision Planner:** This sets out the entire examination season on a single page to help students plan their independent study at home around each examination.
- 5) **Prayer cards.** These are pocket-sized cards, so students can keep them in their blazers and always have a prayer in their hand to bring them strength and blessings.
- 6) **Good Luck Card:** Each student has a personal good luck card written by a member of staff.

Please look out for your child brining this home and ensure your child keeps it safe. The information within these packs is essential and will guide students through the examinations so they always know what is happening and will feel more confident. Working through the exam packs with your child daily will help to keep them organized and on track.
