#### **Options Evening – 28 January 2025**

As we strive to provide the broadest and most personalised curriculum to our students at Key Stage 4, we invite Year 9 students and their parents and carers to attend the Year 9 Options evening.

On Tuesday 4 February 2025 we are holding the Year 9 Parents' Evening in school from 4.00pm – 6.30pm. This will be an opportunity for you to speak to your child's subject teachers about their progress.

Tetanus, Diphtheria & Polio (Td/IPV) & Meningitis ACWY Immunisations are due to take place at your school on **29.1.25**. These vaccines are free of charge.

Most children have been immunised against Tetanus, Diphtheria & Polio and Meningitis C as part of the childhood UK schedule. Guidance from NHS England recommends that your child now receives a booster dose of Tetanus, Diphtheria & Polio and Meningitis ACWY.
