Frequency of homework: <i>how often will my child be given homework?</i>	Format of homework: <i>what will my child be asked to do for homework?</i>	Expectations for homework: <i>how long is my child expected to spend on homework tasks and how will they know the quality of work expected from them?</i>	Assessment of homework: <i>how will my child's homework be assessed?</i>
Once a week or once a fortnight depending on individual work rate.	Complete work linked to GCSE Assessment Objectives: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Artist research AO1</li> <li>• Observational Studies AO2</li> <li>• Design development AO3</li> <li>• Final piece AO4.</li> </ul>	Approximately 45 minutes on each task. (However, work students are completing for homework may be continuous pieces that were not completed in lesson.)  Examples of work are shared with students for each assessment objective.	This work will be part of the student's projects which forms their portfolio of course work (60% of the overall GCSE grade).
