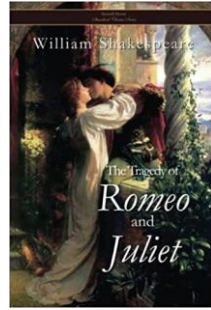


Year 7 Learning Journey: English

In this unit you will be introduced to the world of William Shakespeare through studying one of his most famous plays. You will learn about the context of the play and will understand some of the features of a tragedy play.

Reading Assessment: Shakespeare Analysis

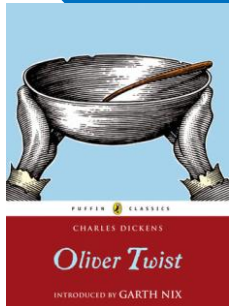
By the end of Year 7:
