| <p>Homework will be set once every 2 weeks.</p> | <p>Homework will consist of a variety of tasks, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Exam questions • Revision • Online tests • Tasks to embed knowledge and understanding. • Retention and recall activities. | <p>Students should spend no longer than 30 minutes on any piece of homework.</p> <p>All homework should be presented neatly, and completed in full sentences, with care taken over spelling, punctuation and grammar.</p> <p>Each piece of homework will be clearly explained so that the students know what is expected, however, if there is any uncertainty, the students can contact their class teacher via Teams to seek clarification.</p> | <p>Assessment of a homework task will depend upon the nature of the homework task that is set. All homework will be marked by staff, and feedback will be provided to the students.</p> <p>Exam questions – Exam board mark scheme.</p> <p>Online tests – Immediate feedback provided.</p> <p>Tasks to embed knowledge and understanding – Marked by teacher with feedback provided.</p> <p>Retention and recall activities - Marked by teacher with feedback provided.</p> |
