Location of countries, capitals, links to the EU and importance of the local area

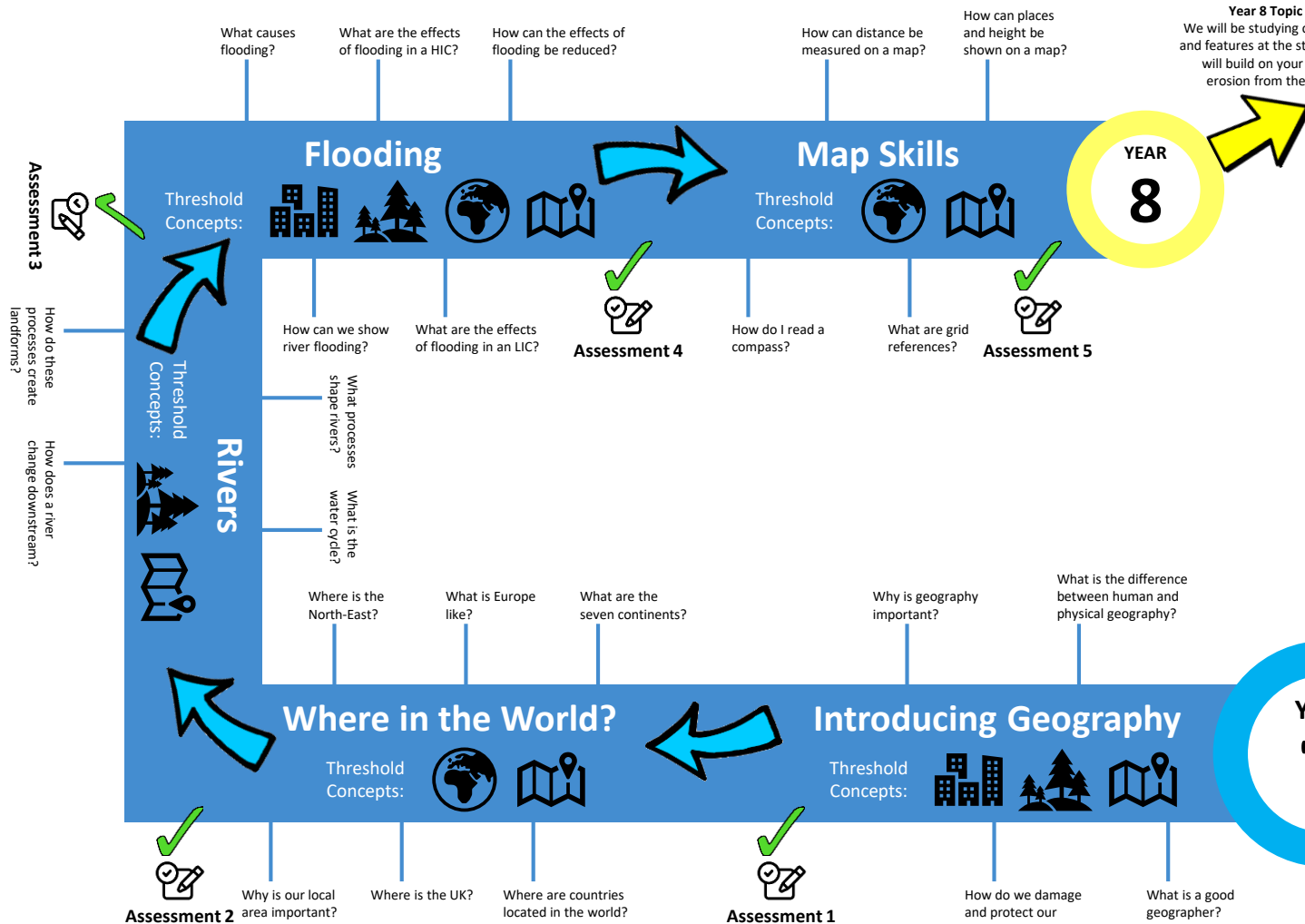
River processes and the features formed by them
