2: Cold Environments Location, features and adaptations of cold environments, the impacts humans have on the fragility and how this is managed

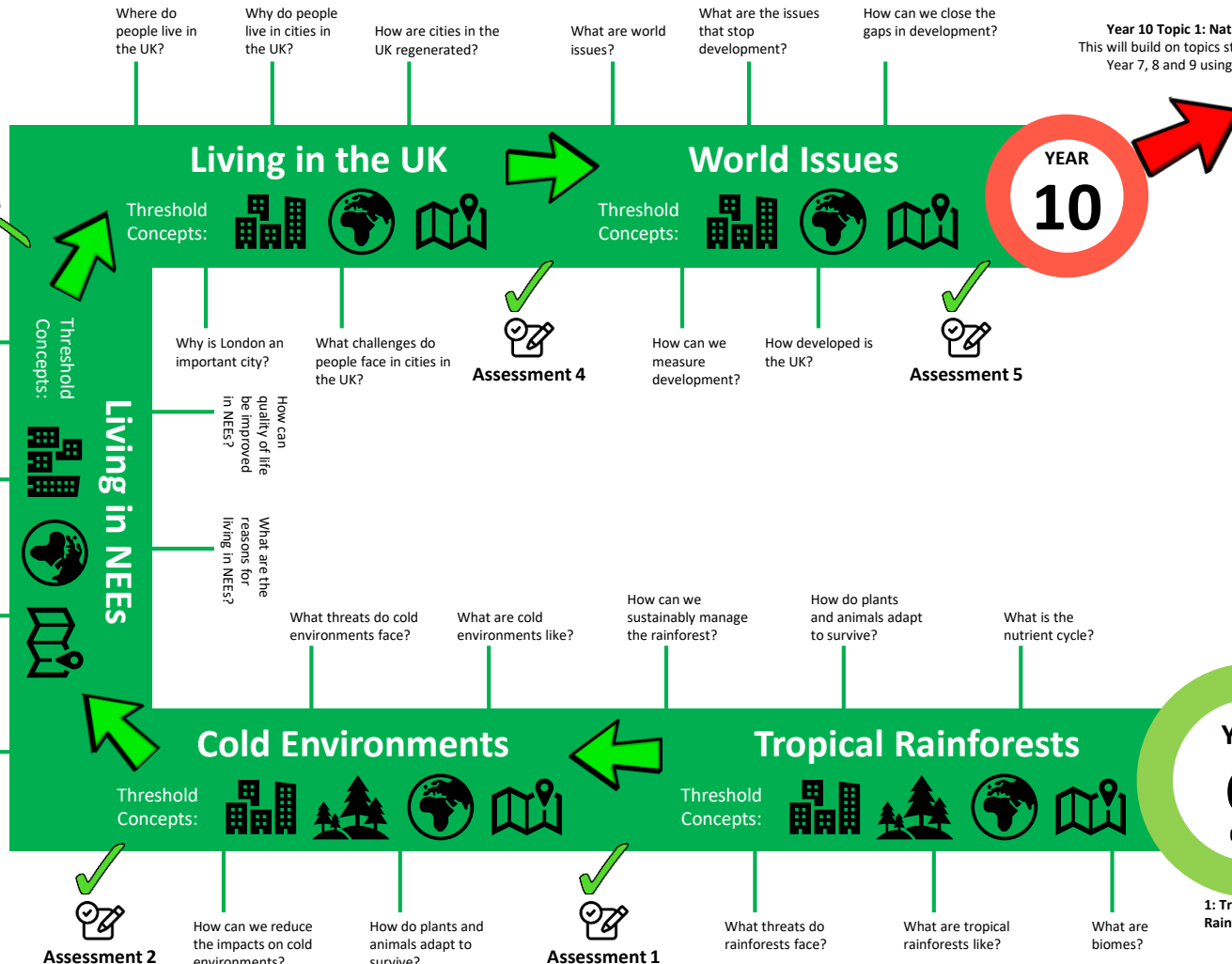
3: Living in NEEs Reasons for growth of cities, opportunities and challenges of living in NEE's and strategies to improve living standards
