St Michael's Remembrance Event, Friday 11 November 2022

I am delighted to announce that on Friday 11 November, the Academy will hold a whole school Remembrance event where we will be remembering the sacrifice of those who have died in battle. St Michael's has a tradition of marking Remembrance, and we are proud to invite the community to join us for this poignant event.

The event will be held at the front of school in our bus bay, on Beamish Road at 11.00am. Students, staff, parents, carers and the local community are invited to gather at this location at 10.50am to prepare for the event and we will arrange the minute silence as follows:

- Students will gather in year groups in the area behind the bus bay.
- Parents and members of the local community will gather on the other side of the wall running along Beamish Road.
- A first whistle will sound at 11.00am to signal the start of the minute silence.
- A second whistle will sound at 11:01am to signal a minute of applause to thank those who have made their sacrifice.
- A third whistle will sound, and students will return to the Academy building.

After the minute silence, visitors are welcome to attend our 'Tommy silhouette' installation to lay a poppy, wreath or simply a note containing a prayer.
