The summer term is upon us once again and we are just one week away from the start of the formal Year 11 summer GCSE exams. Please can I ask that you keep our Year 11 students in your thoughts and prayers as they begin this important phase in their academic careers.

Current Year 10 students have made an excellent start to their mock exams; attendance has been excellent from this year group and everybody has coped well with the formal exam hall arrangements, well done Year 10 so far.

There has also been a very positive start to the summer term for all our KS3 students who have returned with great enthusiasm for the final term.

Over the Easter holidays we have had some work completed in the school building to the toilet areas.
