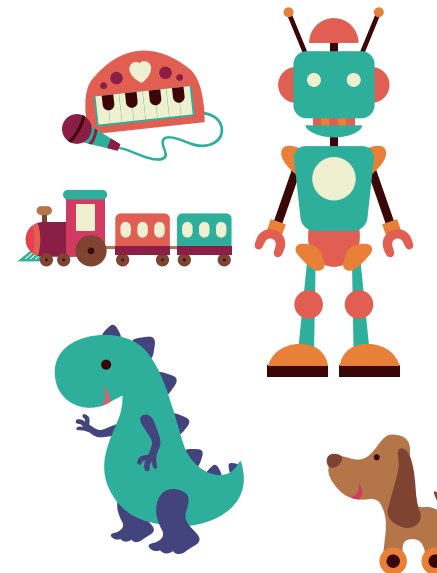
The funds raised last year by FOSM will be spent on the following:
