Welcome!

Meet the Teacher Y1 and Y2

Meet The Teacher YR

Although most parents of new YR children will have had an opportunity to meet their child's class teacher, we would like to provide an additional opportunity for this after school on **Wednesday 14th September**. There is no need to book, but if your child is in YR and you would like to pop in and have a chat with teachers, they will all be available until 5pm. Please come to the main school door and buzz, and we will let you in.

Reading at Home

We are introducing a new incentive to encourage children to read regularly at home. We request that all children read at home a minimum of 3 times a week, and ideally daily, just for a short time. Parents are asked to sign the reading diary every time children read at home. Each month a trophy will be awarded to the class where the highest percentage of children have read at home at least 3 times a week. Children in Y1 and Y2 have seen the trophy and they are very excited! The competition in September will just be for them, with YR being included as from October.

Reading for YR parents

Communication with Parents

Our main method of communication with parents is via our website www.st-michaels-inf.hants.sch.uk, where notifications about everything happening in school will be posted. In response to parental requests following last term's parent questionnaire, we will send occasional newsletters such as this. Every Monday the school office will send parents a 'Message Monday' email, with reminders of deadlines and events, including notifications to check the website for details of specific activities. If you are not receiving your 'Message Monday' email for any reason, please let the school office know as soon as possible, so that you don't miss out!

WOW! Walk Once a Week

The school is once again participating in WOW! to encourage children to walk to school once a week.

Children who walk one day a week for a month (4 or 5 times a month) will earn a WOW badge. These badges have a different theme each month, so the children can collect the set.

We understand that walking the entire journey may not be an option for some families, so it is fine to drive part of the way and walk for the last 5-10 minutes. You can walk to school any day or days each week.

In order to record when the children have walked to school, each class will have a WOW wall chart, the day(s) that children have walked can be ticked. There will also be a trophy for the class that walks the most each month.

Taking part in this is optional, although we hope that many of our children will be able to join in.
