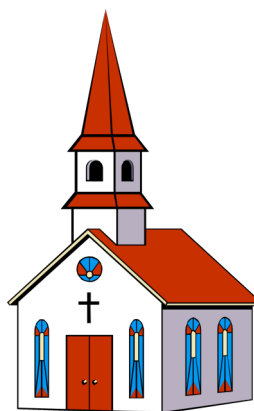
Coats, Bottles, PE Kit
