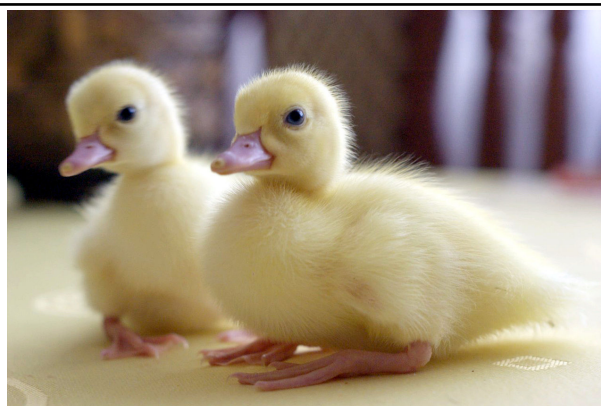
Films rated '18'
