

Year One

Autumn Term

In **RE**, we will learn about the Harvest and how we can help others. Later in the term, we will focus on why we receive and give gifts at Christmas time.



As **mathematicians**, we will be learning about the place value of numbers to 20. We will also be learning strategies for addition and subtraction. In geometry, we will be learning about 2D and 3D shapes.

As **readers** and **writers**, we will be focusing on historical and traditional texts. We will be writing narrative and non-narrative pieces. We will continue with our daily Phonics and Reading lessons.



As **geographers**, we will learn all about the countries that make up the UK. We will be using our map work skills to locate countries and understand what different symbols mean.

As **scientists**, we will be identifying the features and uses of a range of materials. We will be asking questions and carrying out investigations. We will be using our observation skills to answer questions.

As **artists**, we will be focusing on the work of Hundertwasser. We will use drawing, painting and IT skills to produce a piece of Blackpool artwork.



As **historians**, we will be focusing on toys that our grandparents may have played with. We will be looking at school days in the past and ordering artefacts in chronological order.



As **musicians**, we will rehearse and perform with others using un-tuned instruments. We will also look at key composers, listening to and appraising their work.

In **PE**, we will be continuing to work on our fine and gross motor skills. We will be developing our coordination, balance and control.

In **Computing**, we will learn about technology all around us. We will learn how to log on to a computer and use a keyboard and mouse.



In **DT**, our learning will focus around designing, making and evaluating towers.

In **PSHE**, we will be learning about our rights and responsibilities. We will celebrate our differences by looking at similarities and differences in everyone.

Spring Term

In **RE**, we will learn about how and why Jesus was special. Later in the term, we will learn about celebrating new life and new beginnings at Easter.



As **mathematicians**, we will be continuing to learn about the place value of numbers to 50 and strategies for addition and subtraction. We will also be comparing lengths and heights as well as being introduced to weight and mass.

As **readers and writers**, we will be focusing on detective and portal stories. We will be writing narrative, non-narrative and poetry pieces. We will continue with our daily Phonics and Reading lessons.

As **geographers**, we will learn all about key features of our local area. We will be using our map skills to create a journey from home to school.

As **scientists**, we will be learning all about the basic structure of plants and trees. We will investigate what a plant needs to live and grow well.



As **artists**, we will be focusing on the work of local artist John Ditchfield.

As **historians**, we will be learning about the lives of famous people who have lived in Blackpool. We will learn about why they were famous and their achievements.



As **musicians**, we will be experimenting with creating and copying musical patterns.

In **PE**, we will be continuing to work on our coordination and balance in gymnastics. We will also be continuing to practise our throwing and catching skills.

In **Computing**, we will learn how to use technology safely to create digital paintings and handle data.

In **DT**, our learning will focus around designing, making and evaluating a product using sliders and levers.

In **PSHE**, we will be learning about celebrating successes and achievements, keeping ourselves healthy and linking health and happiness.



Year One

Summer Term

In **RE**, we will learn about why baptism is special. Later in the term, we will look at what Christians believe God is like.



As **mathematicians**, we will be learning about the place value of numbers to 100 and strategies for multiplication and division. We will also be looking at fractions, position and direction, money and time.

As **readers** and **writers**, we will be focusing on adventurous fiction texts. We will be writing narrative, non-narrative and poetry pieces. We will continue with our daily Phonics and Reading lessons.

As **geographers**, we will learn all about key features of hot and cold places. We will be using our map skills to find and compare hot and cold places around the world.

As **scientists**, we will be learning all about animals including humans. We will focus on the human body, the senses and how animals are grouped.



As **artists**, we will be focusing on the work of artist Giuseppe Arcimboldo.

As **historians**, we will be learning about our local history, with a particular focus on our school. We will look at how the area has changed over time.
