## Autumn Term

In **RE**, we will be exploring life as a journey and religious pilgrimages. Later in the term, we will be learning about how Christians prepare for Christmas.



As **mathematicians**, we will be learning about the place value numbers. We will be developing efficient strategies for addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will also be exploring fractions.

As **readers and writers** we will be analysing the features of narrative, non-narrative and poetry texts. We will be writing our own narratives, explanation texts and balanced arguments. We will continue with our spelling and Reading lessons.

As **geographers**, we will be learning all about human and physical disasters across the world. We will also be exploring the effects of climate change.

As **scientists**, we will be learning about how the Earth and living things change over time. We will be classifying plants and animals.



As **artists**, we will be focusing on the wildlife artist Richard Symonds. We will be developing our skills in drawing and painting.



As **historians**, we will be studying the history of the Tudors. We will learn about Tudor houses and the fashion of the time.

As **musicians**, we will be developing our composition skills. We will be using our voices to sing with clear diction.

In **PE**, we will be developing skills in dance, gymnastics and team games. We will also be receiving training as Playground Pals.

In **Computing**, we will explore the use of search engines, evaluate different methods of communication and know how to stay safe online. We will also learn how to use a computer to create 3D digital objects.



In **DT**, we will be designing, making and evaluating a habitat for an animal.

In **PSHE**, we will set our own goals for the year. We will explore the concept that our actions can affect others locally and globally.



As **linguists**, we will be learning how to conjugate regular verbs. We will be learning how to tell the time in French and how to discuss what we have done at the weekends. We will also be developing our written French skills.
