

St. Nicholas Church of England Primary School –

Timetable for Phased Re-opening.

Year 6 Children

Keyworker children remain in school every day in keyworker groups (as per the last 11 weeks) in their own 'bubbles'.

Monday 8th & Tuesday 9th June – School open to Keyworker children only and all staff to be trained in small groups in new policy & procedures, including the use of PPE.

Wednesday 10th June – School remains open to Keyworker children

- ✓ **School to welcome back Reception children**

Tuesday 16th June - School remains open to Keyworker children

- ✓ **School to welcome back YEAR 6 children**
- ✓ Children to be dropped off in the window of - **9.05am – 9.20am**. Parents must adhere to these strict time allocated slots.
- ✓ Children to be dropped off at the school gate – **NO PARENTS** will be allowed onto the school playground. There will be clear 2m distancing measures in place and staff will be on hand to supervise.
- ✓ Year 6 **MUST** be collected between **2.45pm and 3:00pm** from the same drop off / collection point.

Year 6 children will then be in school **Tuesday – Friday weekly**. School will be CLOSED for Y6 'bubble' classes on Mondays for a DEEP CLEAN.

- Children will be placed in groups of up to 8 children per 'bubble'
- They will be in a classroom with one teacher and one Teaching Assistant – they will be allocated a desk (2m socially distant)
- They will be able to complete the work set on Class Dojo by their class teacher. This is the same work they can complete if they remain at home – the activities are exactly the same.
- Each 'bubble' of 8 children will have allocated times for outdoor playtime and lunch breaks.
- Lunch will be eaten in the classroom
