

# Christian Values

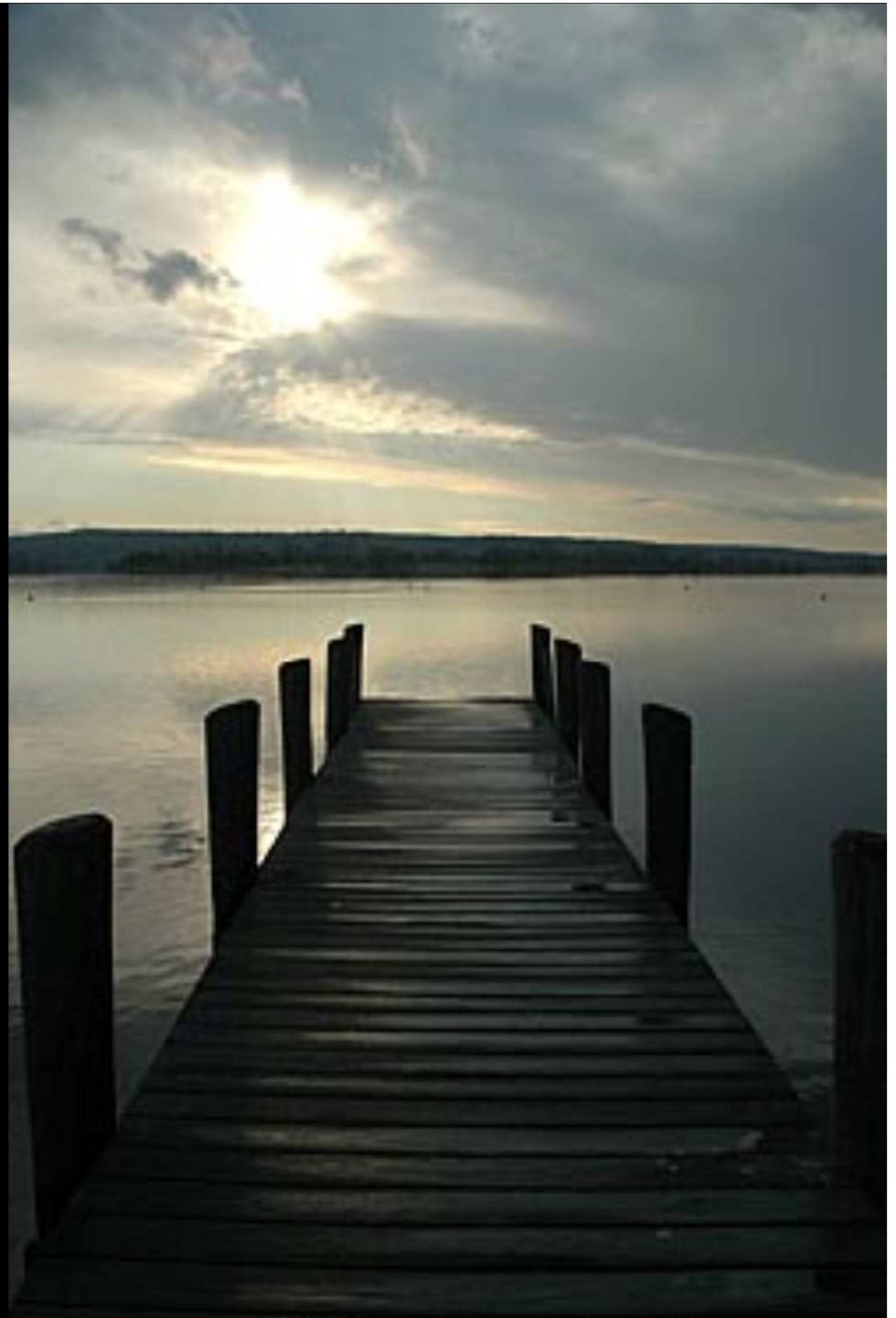
We believe that Christian values are central to the life and work of our school and use them as our guiding principles for life and relationships.
