Curriculum:

Here's a what we will be learning about this term:

English: Ready Steady Write - Old Bear and Rapunzel

Maths: Place Value (within 20), Addition and Subtraction, Place Value (within 50), Length and Height, Mass and Volume.

History - The Gunpowder Plot.

Geography - Weather and climate.

Science - The human body, and the seasons.

Art - Spirals

RE - How might your religion or worldview be seen in the choices you make?

PE - OAA and Dance

Home Tasks:

READING:

Children will bring home reading books usually on a Wednesday. They should read with you, or independently, a minimum of 3 times per week for 10 minutes. Children receive special reading stickers when it is signed x3 weekly. Children read to an adult daily, in a variety of contexts but this will not necessarily be recorded in planners

PHONICS:

Phonics homework is given out every Thursday. To consolidate their learning, your child will have already completed the two pages in school. Sparkly phonics stickers are rewarded when homework is handed in.
