Advise for sickness and diarrhoea	We have had a few cases of sickness and diarrhoea in school. Our school policy is that children must remain off for 48 hours from the last bout of sickness or diarrhoea. Below is some guidance from the NHS. https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/diarrhoea-and-vomiting/
Sun protection	As the weather warms up and our children spend more time outdoors, we'd like to remind everyone about the importance of sun protection. Here are some simple steps we can all take to ensure our children stay safe in the sun: * Sunscreen: Please apply a sunscreen with an SPF of 30 or higher to your child's exposed skin before they come to school. If children are bringing sunscreen to school to reapply, please ensure it is in a clear plastic bag with their name on. * Hats: Wide-brimmed hats are excellent for shielding the face, ears, and neck from the sun. Please ensure your child has a suitable hat for outdoor activities. Please ensure they are plain dark blue/ black without a logo/ brand, in line with our uniform policy. * Sunglasses: We would prefer that children wear a wide brimmed hat to shield their eyes. Only good quality sunglasses that provide 100% UVA and UVB protection are permitted in school. Children are responsible for looking after their sunglass. Please ensure all items are labelled.
