Vaccination Consents	Our local school-aged immunisation service in Warwickshire has been working with NHS England on improving how vaccinations in schools are managed. As part of this work, the School-Aged Immunisation Service Team will now contact you directly to request consent for vaccinations. The new approach will make it quicker and easier for you to give or refuse consent for vaccinations. This new process will allow the follow up of uncompleted consent forms to happen automatically if we have not received them. What we will share with the school-aged immunisation service team: When the School-Aged Immunisation Service Team asks our school for class lists, we will provide email addresses and phone numbers for parents and guardians of children who are eligible for vaccinations. The School-Aged Immunisation Service Team will use these contact details to send consent requests and reminders to parents and guardians. Parking enforcement	We know families have shared concerns about unsafe parking and congestion at drop off and pick up. Off the back of a recent site visit carried out by Stratford District Council, we have been informed that they will be providing enhanced parking enforcement. Below is an extract of their e-mail. From September, we will begin providing <u>enhanced parking enforcement</u> support around a number of primary priority schools in Warwickshire. Your school has been assessed and has been included in this first tranche which is planned to go live in the Autumn term. Our primary focus will be to deter and prevent illegal parking on school keep clear (zig-zag) markings, and the double yellow lines supporting the school aiming to educate drivers and to ensure safer access for children and families. Vehicles parked in contravention will be issued with a Penalty Charge Notice (PCN). To enable this enforcement, existing zig-zag markings must meet legal standards. This includes ensuring that each set of markings is clearly visible and accompanied by appropriate signage indicating the parking restrictions. Improvement works are currently underway and are scheduled for completion ahead of the September rollout.
