With this in mind, Warwickshire County Council's Road Safety Education Team have given the following advice. <i>Supervising Children and Encouraging Safe Travel</i> <i>When walking with your children, please always hold their hands, especially younger children. Remember, your children learn by watching you. Set a good example by following safe road practices.</i> <i>We encourage children who walk, cycle, or scooter to school independently to be extra vigilant. Please remind them to:</i> • <i>Be observant of traffic.</i> • <i>Look very carefully both ways before crossing any roads.</i> • <i>Be aware of their surroundings.</i> • <i>If children are cycling or scooting, please remind them to get off their bicycles or scooter when crossing the road.</i> • <i>Find a safe place to cross, and cross away from parked vehicles.</i>
