Reading

In Year 2, we focus on developing children's **fluency, stamina, and comprehension**. Reading books are changed weekly.

Children should **bring their reading book and planner into school every day** and take them home each afternoon.

It is essential that your child reads with an adult at least **three times per week for 10 minutes or more**. Regular practice will help them grow in confidence and enjoyment as reader

Please initial your child's planner each time they read to earn house points.
