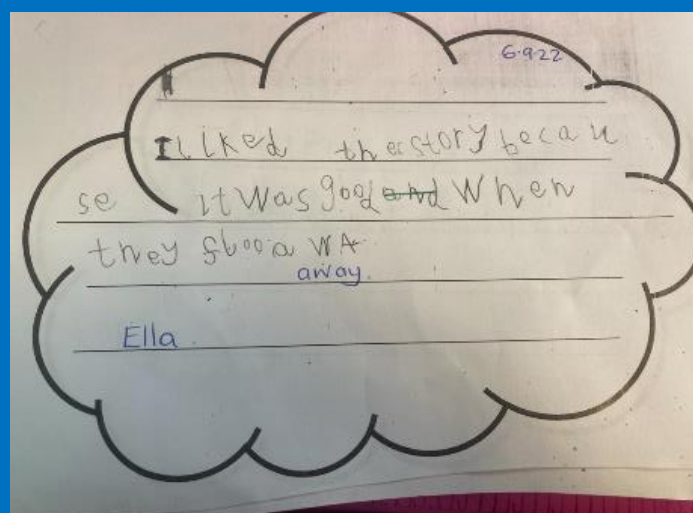
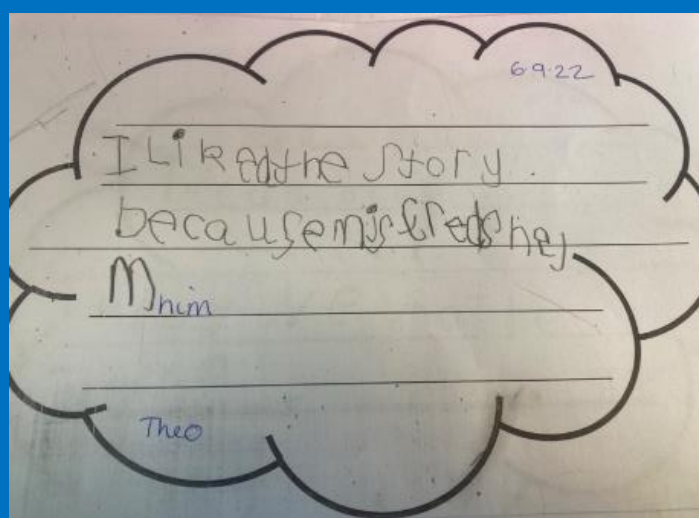
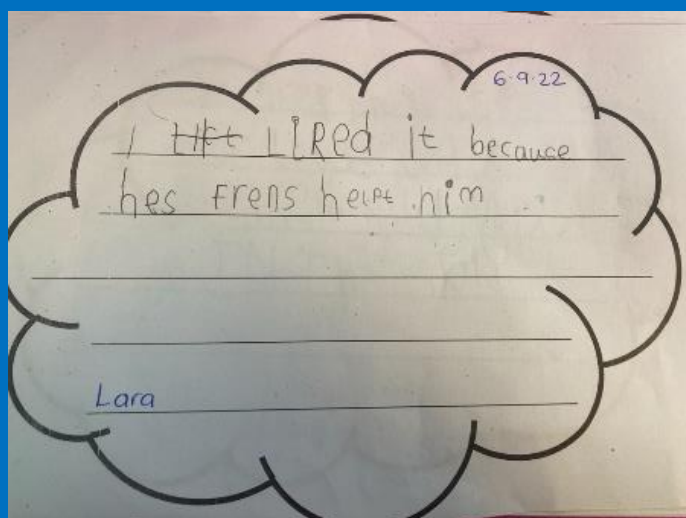
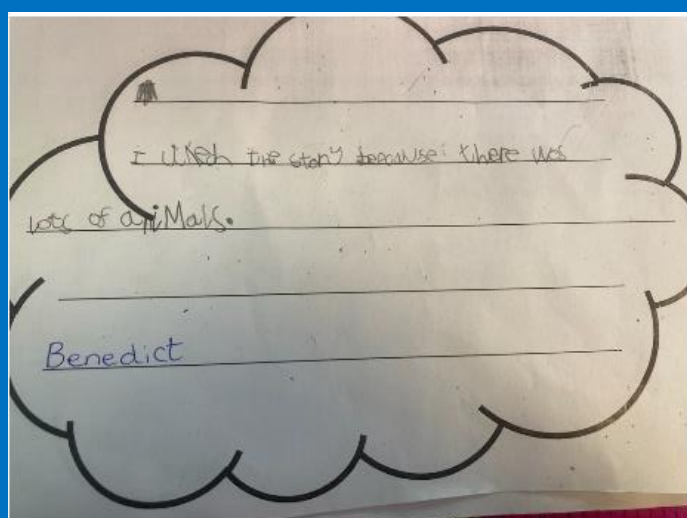


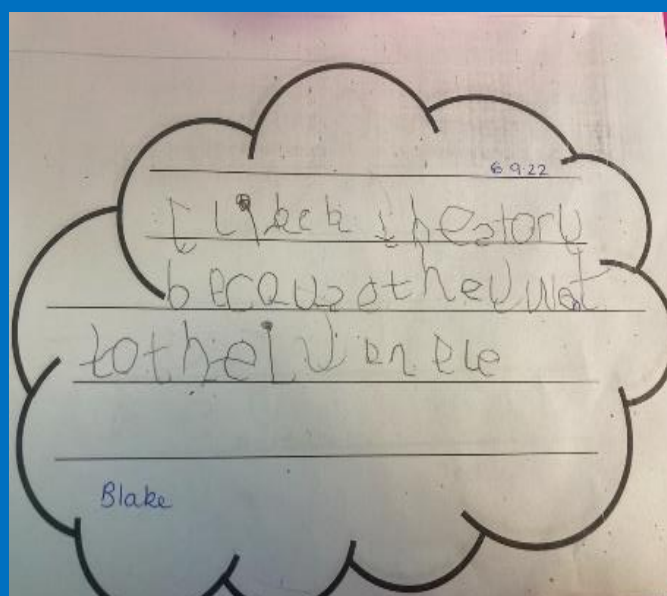
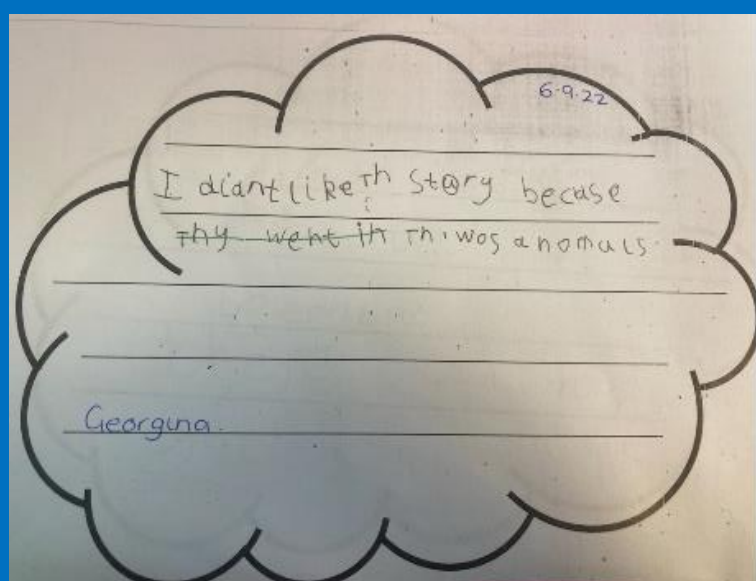
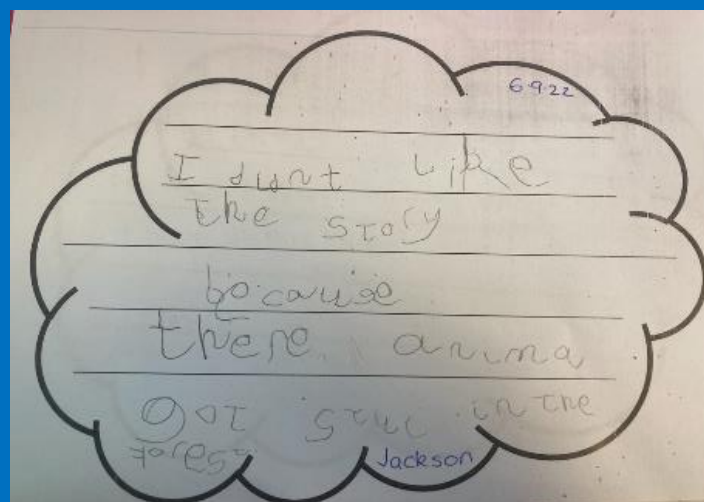
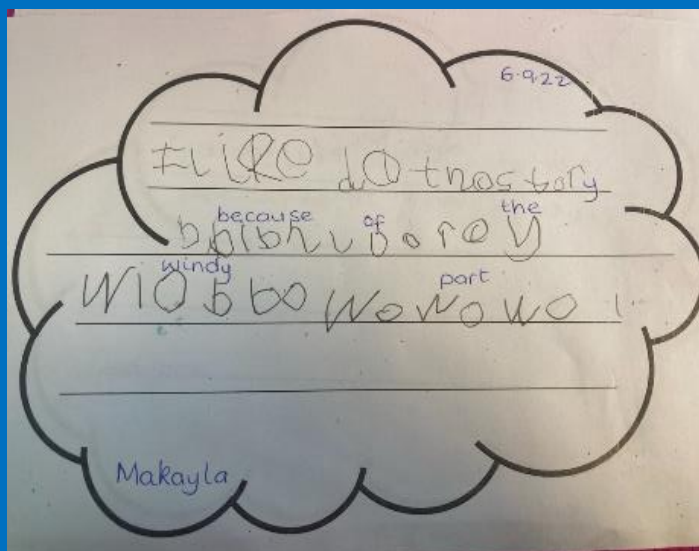
Welcome to Sparrows book first book blog of the school year! In our first week as Year 1's we have been reading 'Blown Away' by Rob Biddulph.
