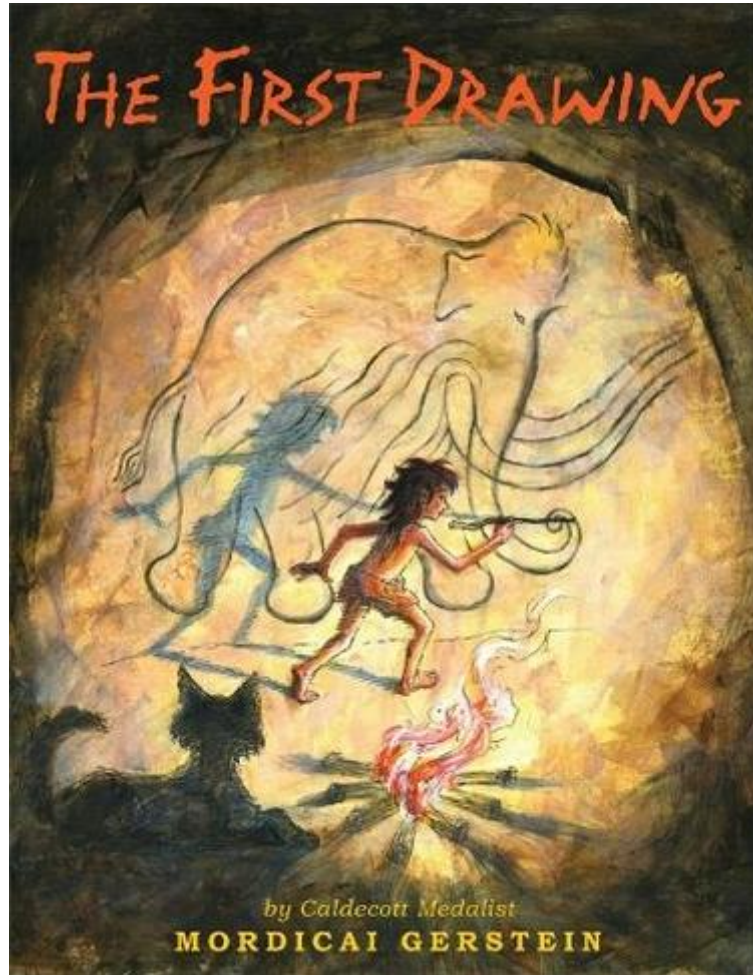


**This week we have started our new text
