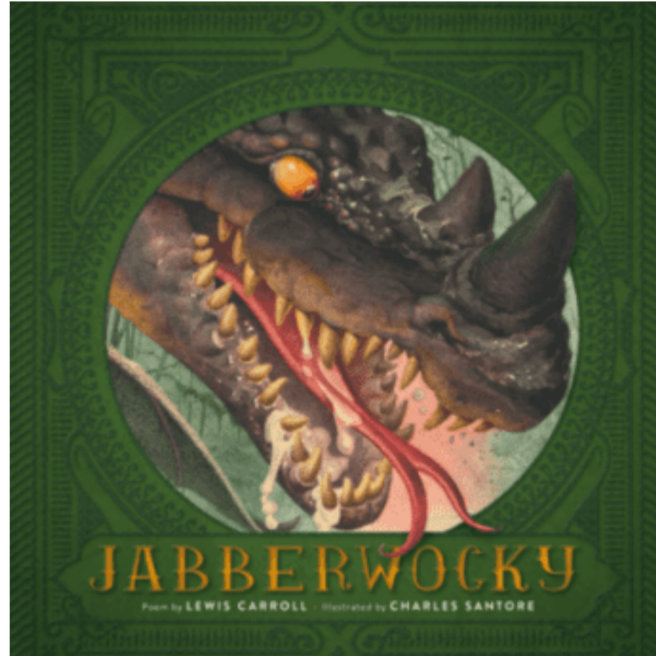


# Magpies' Book Blog

# Here are some verses of the nonsense poems we wrote!

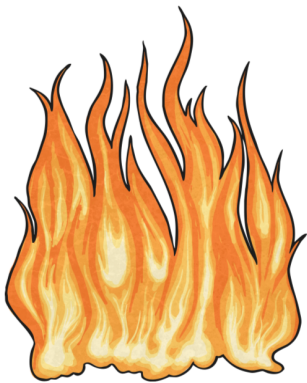
'Twas screepy on the cilent beach,
