### Make Some Music



#### How do brass instruments make a sound?






After watching the video can you answer the following questions:


- 1. When air vibrates slowly does this create a higher or a lower note?

Can you draw the notes C, D & E in the correct places on the staves below? Refer to the music on the other pages to help you.













#### Fingering and note values for valved instruments
