David Childs is another fantastic brass soloist who plays the euphonium, pronounced [YOO] + [FOH] + [NEE] + [UHM]. The euphonium is similar to the baritone which some of you are learning, but is slightly larger.

Here David is playing *Flight of the Bumblebee* which is a very challenging piece due to the extremely fast tempo (speed).

	When changing between D and E keep your first finger down on valved instruments
	Don't forget to hold on to the minims on the second line for 2 beats.
	This is a one beat rest. In this piece don't forget to stomp/ stamp your foot on the rests.
	Watch out for the dots at the start and the end of this piece. They are repeat signs. When you get to the end, don't forget to go back to the beginning and play the piece again.
